Results Year 3 91% SEA – Achieved, Year 5 94% SEA – Achieved	If we consistently use high impact teaching strategies to support students in developing and structuring written texts, we will increase the number of students achieving SEA and attaining higher bands in writing.	<p>We will see each student set, monitor &amp; achieve personalised writing goals, referenced against the Brighpath Teaching Points, and be able to articulate next steps in their learning.</p>
	2023: 92% of Year 3 and 5 students will attain SEA in writing as measured by NAPLAN (40 out of 44 students). Higher band retention from Year 3 to Year 5 for 100% of students.		
	2024: 94% of Year 3 and 5 students will attain SEA in writing as measured by NAPLAN. Higher band retention will be maintained at Year 5 for 100% of students.


**Goal 3: Increase the number of students achieving SEA and in the higher bands in numeracy.**

2022: NAPLAN Year 3 - 90% SEA & 35% HB Results 87% SEA & 31% HB (not achieved) Year 5 - 87% SEA & 30% HB Results 94% SEA & 36% HB (achieved)
2023: NAPLAN Year 3 - 90% SEA, 39 out of 44 students & 35% HB, 15 out of 44 Year 5 - 90% SEA, 55 out of 62 students & 35% HB, 21 out of 62
2024: NAPLAN Year 3 - 92% SEA & 37% HB Year 5 - 92% SEA & 37% HB

If we implement an evidence-based program to explicitly teach mathematics, Reception to Year 6, then we will increase the number of students achieving SEA and in the higher bands in Numeracy.

We will see each student demonstrate improved confidence and results in number. Each student will set, monitor & achieve personalised numeracy goals.
